For Immediate Release, February 22, 2021, Tavares, FL: Lake 100 announces the launch of the Lake County Coalition for Housing and Economic Development (CHED), established as a result of the Lake 100 and Lake County Board of County Commissioners Workforce Housing Strategic Plan. The Lake CHED is a national model for addressing workforce housing issues faced by many communities around the U.S.

Lake CHED was established as a non-profit public/private partnership that will evaluate, research and recommend changes and adoptions of policies and practices that impact workforce housing, and economic development in general.

Lake CHED will focus on increasing housing access and opportunities for those entry level workforce citizens of Lake County. Driven by business leaders, CHED is partnering with county and municipal officials to establish a new transformational model for creating housing access and opportunity for Lake County's highly valued workforce.

Lake CHED consists of a Board of Directors and six task teams: Funding and Subsidy, Model Communities, Land Use, Data Management, Program Administration and Economic & Commercial Development.
